These three women have unique artistic styles and a different approach to their creative expressions. Originally from the US, England and Russia, their perspectives are vibrant and diverse. Inspiration comes from cultural background, sacred geometry and spontaneous interpretation.

Jonna Jackson, a self-taught artist inspired by God's creation, works with mixed media to create intricate three-dimensional paintings which often include cloth, metal, paint, and custom beads.

Christina Green-Martinez studied art at the University of Texas, but it wasn't until she attended a lecture by the genius, architect, and philanthropist Buckminster Fuller that her artistic vision became clear. She understood that Fuller described the essence of life through a universal perspective. He was the inspiration for her geometric series. Her Motto: *From the finite to the infinite, all is connected.*

Anastasia Seremetis brings the flavor of her Russian culture to Imagine Art's studio where she is involved with ceramics, painting and sewing. She has been sewing for the last eight years, and in the Russian tradition, Anastasia also makes handmade dolls.

That said, the appreciation for creative expression, and how that impacts the world, has established a timeless connection between the three.
